

## Rhapis excelsa - Broadleaf Lady Palm



Rhapis excelsa – Broadleaf Lady Palm is an attractive short palm producing fan like leaves along tall narrow stems.

**Height:** Up to three metres, but very slow growing

**Uses:** An excellent elegant palm for shaded areas, offering attractive architectural foliage.

**Planting tips:** Must be grown in low light or shaded areas. Relatively drought tolerant once established.

**Soil type:** The soil for this plant must be well drained as well as rich in humus, though these palms seem to grow in any soil.

Water requirement: Water daily in hot conditions

**Pruning:** Prune off dead fronds as needed.

**Pests and problems:** Occasional attacks of mealy bugs. You can use an insecticidal soap to terminate the scale.

Climate: Grows well in almost all Australian region
