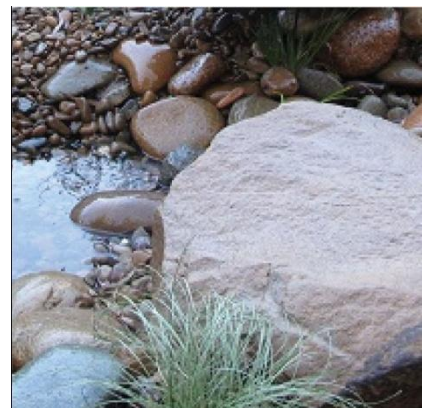
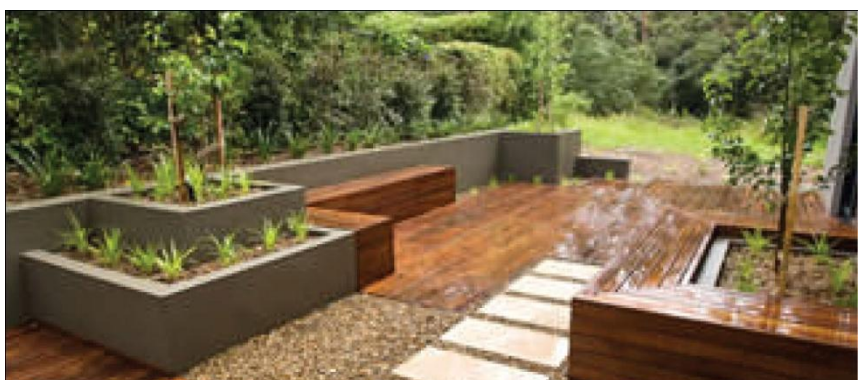

Design Concept

General Garden Advice

The following is general advice that is relevant to all gardens.

- Add organic matter to your soil to improve the nutrients, water holding capabilities and soil structure. You generally only get one chance to add LOTS of organic matter to your soil. Go overboard! Organic matter is the key to excellent soil and therefore excellent plant health.
- Mulch your garden to reduce weeds, feed the soil and regulate both temperature and moisture.
- Never allow your soil to totally dry out, this can cause irreparable damage. Ideally keep your soil at least slightly moist.
